Conference Theme

The first edition of the "EnviLink - International platform for exchange of experience between young scientists in environmental research" conference is planned for May 2024. The idea behind its organization is to create an event that would integrate and consolidate the community of young scientists in Poland and abroad, providing a venue for presenting their research experiences, discussing opportunities and barriers for young scientists' development, and indicating directions for further scientific careers. The conference aims to be a place for building a network of contacts, which in the future may result in the creation of interdisciplinary research teams. Workshops are also planned to enhance the qualifications of young scientists.

The conference is intended for students and young researchers conducting research in the fields of forest, Earth and environmental sciences. The EnviLink conference will include plenary sessions on general topics aimed at presenting young scientists' experiences in conducting scientific research in units outside Poland. In these sessions, presentations will be presented by invited speakers from abroad. There will also be thematic sessions (FOREST, CITY, WATER, CLIMATE, TECHNOLOGY) which, although presenting scientific research in various scientific disciplines, are closely related in terms of subject matter. **The connecting element of the individual sessions will be the use of broadly understood Geographic Information Systems (GIS) in the indicated areas.** Through GIS, we understand a kind of platform for collecting, managing, and analyzing spatial data. Such systems are currently used in most areas of life. In environmental research, spatial data are used, among others, for modeling the impact of climate change on ecosystems, assessing the state of ecosystems, or in analyses of urban heat islands. Research using GIS is mainly conducted by interdisciplinary teams. Many developed models and tools are successfully applied in decision-making systems at various levels of state and local administration and other state units. Therefore, building a platform for exchanging experiences among scientists in this area can result in significant research and implementations in the subject area.

The conference is funded by the Ministry of Education and Science as part of the Excellent Science II program – Support for scientific conferences and the Institute's own resources.
